Camberwell Central Bowls Club COVIDSafe plan 2020

This plan details how the club will ensure all relevant directions are followed to minimize the chances of transmission, protect the health system and save lives.

COVID 19 will be with us for some time, so it's important that our club has a plan -and continues to plan -to keep your workplace healthy, safe and virus-free.

All Australian Governments have agreed to a set of <u>National COVID-19 Safe Work Principles</u> to guide us and ensure that our club is a healthy and safe place.

This plan includes

facility access only for use of toilets

Until council releases the lockdown on clubrooms, players/visitors can access the public toilet block in the grounds behind the bowls club.

Once access to clubroom toilets is available, only one person will be allowed into the toilets at a time.

enhanced cleaning/sanitizing practices, including signage

Have hand sanitizer stations at entry and exit points and around the club

Ensure bathrooms are well stocked with hand wash and paper towel. † Put up posters with instructions on how to hand wash/hand rub.

Instruct members/visitors on other ways to limit the spread of germs, including by not touching their face, sneezing into their elbow, staying home if feeling sick and no shaking hands or touching objects unless necessary.

Increase access to closed bins around the club.

enhanced hygiene measures

Ensure any areas frequented by member/visitors are cleaned at least daily with detergent or disinfectant.

Clean frequently touched areas and surfaces several times a day with a detergent or disinfectant solution or wipe. This includes Eftpos equipment, handrails, tables, counter tops, door knobs, sinks and keyboards.

Instruct members/visitors to clean personal property that comes to the club, such as sunglasses, mobile phones and iPads with disinfectant, such as disinfectant wipes.

a process to ensure compliance with 1.5m social distancing rule

Put up posters around the workplace on keeping at least 1.5m distance between everyone at the workplace.

Erect signs at entrances to ensure the maximum safe capacity is not exceeded.

Review deliveries and request contactless delivery.

The following notice will be prominently displayed at the club and the instructions mailed to all full members:

- 2. MAXIMUM 4 BOWLERS PER RINK
- 3. MAXIMUM 10 BOWLERS PER GREEN
- 4. NO HANDLING OFANYONE ELSE'S BOWLS AND EQUIPMENT
- 5. USE 2 JACKS AND MOVE THEM WITH YOUR FEET
- 6. NO ROLLING OF THE JACK FREEHAND
- 7. MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING MINIMUM (1.5M) FROM OTHER BOWLERS AT ALL TIMES
- 8. KEEP HANDS CLEAN, USING SANITISER BEFORE AND AFTER BOWLING
- 9. NO SPECTATORS OR SITTING AROUND THE GREEN
- 10.LEAVE THE CLUB GROUNDS AS SOON AS THE ROLLUP IS OVER
- 11.FAILURE TO FOLLOW ANY OF THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN EXCLUSION FROM THE GREENS
- 12.GREENS CLOSE AT 5.30PM
- 13. ONLY OUTSIDE TOILETSTO BE USED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE
- how a record will be kept of everyone who is using the facility

The Club has developed a roster for practice, which covers a booking system for two-hour sessions morning and afternoon. One person must nominate as the manager of the session to ensure all COVIDSafe compliances are met during the session.

Notices to all members/visitors will confirm restrictions re no competition (even intra club) and no spectators (Bowls Vic guidelines). Entry to the club grounds will only be accessible through the club gates which are governed by the entry of a pin number available exclusively to club members.

Additionally, the club will provide frequent communications through email to all members and users of the club facilities, including compliance updates and the supports available to them.
